MUDGUARD FLAP No. 2550. Of stout smooth enamelled leathercloth, with metal clip to bend around mudguard. Each, 6d.

MUDGUARD FLAP No. 2551. Similar to No. 2550, but in grained enamelled leathercloth. Each, 4d.

SPANNER No. 3. For tension pin and spring nuts. Each, 10d.

SPANNER No. 5. For tension pin and clip nuts of Champion saddles. Each, 1/8

NUMAC. For reproofing oilskin clothing. These quarter-pint tins contain sufficient NUMAC to reproof completely one suit (poncho, leggings and sou'wester) of cyclists' clothing. Yellow or black. Per tin, 1/6
